BURNING INSTRUCTIONS

Before Use:

- Cut the wick $\frac{1}{2}$ cm from the surface of the candle to avoid smoke. We recommend purchasing a Baobab Collection wick trimmer, which makes this task much easier.

During Use:

- Burn the candle until the surface is **COMPLETELY MELTED**. Never blow the wicks out unless you have a pool of wax on the whole surface of the candle. When the wax is liquid, do not burn it for more than an hour. The top layer of liquid wax should never exceed 1cm

Warning: The step above takes longer on the first use. Think about this if you are planning only to be using the candle for a short time. Perhaps a Lodge diffuser of the same fragrance would be a good idea if you have not enough time to light and then burn the candle until the surface has melted as a pool.

- Never surpass the maximum burning time mentioned in the burning instructions
- Don't burn the candle to the very end, keep 1cm of wax at the bottom
- If the wick is not straight, carefully put it back in the right position

WARNING

- Keep a distance of 20cm between two candles that are burning at the same time
- Never burn a candle near inflammable material or a fire or a draught
- Put the candle on a resistant surface
